NEW HEADQUARTERS FOR CANAL+ CYFROWY

CANAL+ CYFROWY colleagues in Poland announce the opening of their new headquarters.



In the shape of a giant "+" sign, the building was designed by the Polish architectural firm Kazimierski and Ryba to convey a high-tech image with materials predominantly in glass, steel and concrete. It is home to over 300 employees, a subscription service and latest-generation technical infrastructures.

Design of technical systems is ultra-securitized and features, for example, a one-megawatt generating unit protected by a complex anti-overvoltage system and lightning arrester, which is, in turn, backed up by an automatic breakdown detection system.

The new infrastructure allows broadcasting the channels in almost all transmission formats, including DVB-S, DVB-S2, DVB-H and DVB-IP.

The 150 m2 studio is fully HD equipped, and CANAL+ CYFROWY uplinks directly from a station installed on the roof of the building.

Key figures for the new CANAL+ CYFROWY headquarters:

- 7 000 m2: total building surface area.
- 60 km: the control room alone is equipped with 60 km of cables.
- From 1.8 to 6.3 meters: diameters of the roof parabolas, which broadcast the 113 channels edited by the Polish subsidiary and receive over 100 channels and radios. The two largest parabolas are automatically oriented toward the satellite.
