CANAL OVERSEAS has announced the launch of the PRV (Personal Video Recorder) system in the Caribbean, Guyana and Reunion Island.

The PVR allows up to 200 hours of recording (50 hrs in high definition) and control live programmes (it is possible to pause the broadcast of a live show).

Thanks to these new functions, subscribers benefit from greater flexibility for viewing of the programmes and therefore make the most of their subscription.

At the same time, CANAL OVERSEAS has launched CANAL+ CINEMA and CANAL+ SPORT in HD exclusively in France, the Caribbean and Guyana.

CANAL ANTILLES, the only operator to broadcast High Definition in the Caribbean and Guyana, now has exclusive broadcast of eight channels : CANAL+ HD, CANAL+ SPORT HD, CANAL+ CINEMA HD, TFI HD, M6 HD, EUROSPORT HD, DISNEY CINEMAGIC HD and NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC CHANNEL HD.

CANAL OVERSEAS has also announced the launch of CANAL CONNECT in partnership with OUTREMER TELECOM, the first alternative telecommunications provider in the Overseas territories. CANAL CONNECT is a dual service offer which includes unlimited telephone calls and broadband Internet up to 8 megabits with a quality customer service and technical assistance at a one of the most competitive reference prices on the market.

The offer will be available in May in the Caribbean, Guyana and Reunion Island from CANAL OVERSEAS and OUTREMER TELECOM stores.
